TEACH IT

This week we will finish our 5-week study of some of God's attributes. Feel free to reopen downloads from May and review any of the amazing truths we have considered this month. Re-read favorite stories; re-watch the best video clips; and re-read passages from God's word!

To summarize this week's truth: God is the standard to determine what is good and what is not. God's ultimate goodness was shown through Jesus' life and death on the cross. You will often make wrong choices and you can never be as good as God. But Jesus meets God's perfect standard and offers to exchange your sin for His perfect goodness. We rely totally on God's perfect goodness—because He is God. You can't earn God's love. You are loved by God, because you are His creation. God loves you because you belong to Him, not because of any goodness you accomplish.

This week, as we consider *God's Goodness and Love* we will let God's Word "do the talking!" Below you will find a passage or passages assigned to each day of the week. Each passage states the truth that God is good and God is love. You can read a passage a day, according to the schedule, or pick a few to go over in one sitting. Enjoy this opportunity to read God's word together with your kids and family!

Good and loving God,

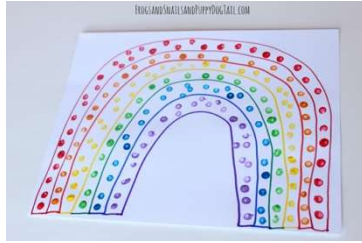
Thank you that you are perfectly good so that I don't have to be perfect.
